Campaign Goal: \$1,265,600

Update the Center (\$278,500)

Our facility upgrades are needed after ten years of use. These include:

Paint and Carpet Replacement	\$205,000	After 10 years of use, the Peggy F. Community Grief Center is in need of fresh paint and carpet replacement.
Lower-Level Conference Video and Audio System	\$50,000	This will enable hybrid and virtual attendance of our educational sessions, workshops and events to ensure than anyone, anywhere can access these offerings. An improved sound system will ensure that every voice is heard during the meetings and presentations that are held in this space.
Community Room Audio System	\$20,000	
Concrete Leveling	\$3,500	This will maintain stability and security of the facility.

Maintain and Enhance the Serenity of Campus (\$62,100)

Labyrinth Construction	\$41,600	A tranquil outdoor labyrinth will offer a space for reflection, meditation, and healing—allowing visitors to find moments of peace during their journey through grief.
Pond Rock Landscaping	\$15,000	Enhancing the natural beauty of our grounds will create a peaceful, nurturing environment for healing and reflection.
Shrub Replacement	\$5,500	A well-maintained landscape speaks to the care and dignity that define our services, offering comfort to all who visit.

Continue and Expand Programs (\$425,000)

Grief affects each person differently, and our programs must reflect that diversity. By introducing innovative services and expanding one-on-one counseling, support groups, and educational workshops, we will ensure that every individual—regardless of background—finds the support they need to heal.
